



## ACROSS

- 3 the naturalist bonsai style that breaks most of the rules
- 5 not suited for broom style bonsai
- 8 the top of the tree
- 9 another name for spherical cutters
- 10 there are only 2 grades of this type of bonsai tool
- 16 also known as "comic" style bonsai
- 18 these trees have more developed and visible root structures
- 20 a tree that does well in the root over rock style of bonsai
- 21 in this style the tip of the bonsai does not drop below the base of the pot
- 22 useful for providing a look of "green velvet" to the surface around your bonsai

## DOWN

- 1 the growing tip of this style of bonsai is below the base of the container
- 2 means large size bonsai
- 4 thought by many to be the most attractive flowering bonsai
- 6 scarring on a bonsai tree should not have this shape
- 7 these bonsai trees are especially susceptible to wire damage during the growing season
- 11 if you do this to bonsai branches the tree will seem taller
- 12 usually trained and presented in the cascade style
- 13 angling the bonsai branches in this direction can indicate great age
- 14 a malleable and easily applied wire used for training bonsai
- 15 bonsai that are 11 inches or less in height
- 17 another name for the formal style of bonsai
- 19 palm sized bonsai
